
Adjectives ending in -ing and -ed (boring/bored etc.)

Many adjectives end in -ing and -ed, for example: boring and bored. Study this example situation:



Jane has been doing the same job for a very long time. Every day she does exactly the same thing again and again. She doesn't enjoy her job any more and would like to do something different.

Jane's job is boring.

Jane is **bored** (with her job).

Compare adjectives ending in -ing and -ed:	
boring. interesting. My job is tiring. satisfying.	 I'm bored with my job. I'm not interested in my job any more I get very tired doing my job. I'm not satisfied with my job.

In these examples, the -ing adjective tells you about the job.

depressing. (etc.)

My job makes me **depressed**. (etc.) In these examples, the **-ed** adjective tells you how somebody feels (about the job).

Compare these examples:

interesting

- Julia thinks politics is interesting.
- Did you meet anyone interesting at the party?

surprising

It was surprising that he passed the exam.

disappointing

The movie was disappointing.
 We expected it to be much better.

shocking

The news was shocking.

interested

- Julia is **interested** in politics.(not interesting in politics)
- Are you **interested** in buying a car? I'm trying to sell mine.

surprised

Everybody was **surprised** that he passed the exam.

disappointed

We were **disappointed** with the movie.
 We expected it to be much better.

shocked

I was shocked when I heard the news.
